

Diversity is a core value of Menarini's commitment to building a culture that respects the uniqueness and valuable contribution of all the people who make up Menarini.





▶ **Fundació Ateneu Sant Roc**

We collaborate with two initiatives aimed at women: the Laila Project, for training women, and the Espai Familiar Elna, aimed at young mothers and their babies.

▶ **Puntos que suman**

We collaborate with the Fundació Joventut Badalona in the "Puntos que suman" (Points that add up) project, organising awareness-raising activities in educational centres in the city.





▶ Càritas Diocesana of Barcelona

Menarini collaborates with the Taller Sant Isidre socio-occupational centre for homeless people, so that they can gradually emerge from the situation of social exclusion in which they live.

▶ Cooperación Internacional

We participate in the campaign 'A Smile for Christmas', which seeks to engage society in helping those most in need.



▶ Maria Assumpta Educational Action Residential Centre (CRAE)

The company has been collaborating for more than 20 years with this centre, which depends on the Department of Labour, Social Affairs and Families of the Generalitat de Catalunya, in the organisation of a Christmas drawing competition and a Christmas party for the children in care.

Menarini has made a donation of 80 reusable sandwich holders to the social initiative cooperative ACTUA for the children who live in the different CRAEs (Educational Action Residential Centres) managed by the organisation.
